### Présent Simple

#### Former le présent simple

	<b>Affirmative</b>	<b>Interrogative</b>	<b>Négative</b>
Je	I think	Do I think?	I do not think / I don't think
Tu / vous	You think	Do you think?	You do not think / You don't think
Il (personne)	He thinks	Does he think?	He does not think / He doesn't think
Elle (personne)	She thinks	Does she think?	She does not think / She doesn't think
Il / elle (objet)	It thinks	Does it think?	It does not think / It doesn't think
Nous	We think	Do we think?	We do not think / We don't think
Ils	They think	Do they think?	They do not think / They don't think

#### Utiliser le présent simple

- Pour des habitudes, des vérités générales, des actions répétées ou des situations immuables, des émotions et des désirs :  
**I smoke** (habitude); **It rains in the Basque Country** (situation immuable); **London is a big city** (vérité générale)
- Pour donner des instructions ou des directives :  
**You walk** for two hundred meters, then **you turn** left.
- Pour exprimer des dispositions fixes, présentes ou futures :  
Your exam **starts** at 09.00

#### Exemples présent simple

Do you speak English? Yes, I do / No, I don't.  
We live in Anglet.  
It flies every day.  
She catches the ball.  
He plays tennis.

Parlez-vous anglais ? Oui. / Non.  
Nous habitons à Anglet.  
Ca vole tous les jours.  
Elle attrape la balle.  
Il joue au tennis.
