Prétérit ou Passé Simple

Former le passé simple verbes réguliers

	Affirmative	Interrogative	Négative
Je	I started	Did I start?	I did not start / I didn't start
Tu / vous	You started	Did you start?	You did not start / You didn't start
Il (personne)	He started	Did he start?	He did not start / He didn't start
Elle (personne)	She started	Did she start?	She did not start / She didn't start
Il / elle (objet)	It started	Did it start?	It did not start / It didn't start
Nous	We started	Did we start?	We did not start / We didn't start
Ils	They started	Did they start?	They did not start / They didn't start

Former le passé simple verbes irréguliers

Les verbes irréguliers changent uniquement dans l'affirmative. Il faut utiliser la base du verbe dans l'interrogative et le négative. Il faut apprendre les verbes irréguliers. Nous pouvons vous donner des tableaux simplifiés de verbes irréguliers.

Utiliser le passé simple

- Pour décrire une action terminée qui a eu lieu dans le passé :
They walked to work on Monday, but they didn't walk to work on Tuesday.
- Nous utilisons souvent les mots et phrases suivants avec le passé simple :
yesterday, last week, last year, in 2010, five years ago.

Exemples passé simple

Did you bring a pen? Yes, you did.

We lived in Anglet.

It flew past every day.

She stopped the car.

Did he email you yesterday? No, he didn't.

Avez-vous amené un stylo? Oui

Nous avons habité à Anglet.

Ca nous a passé en volant tous les jours.

Elle a arrêté la voiture.

Il vous a envoyé un mail hier? Non
